<Highlight 1>: Evaluation reforestation planning workshop with four villages natural resource management committees

In May, our Strategic Coordinator Misbahou Mohamed organized a workshop with four village natural resource management committees on the CRDE (Pomoni) to evaluate our reforestation initiatives since 2016 to-date, and plan out the next campaign. The different committees learnt from each other about what had been working in the different villages, and left motivated to apply the lessons to improve their reforestation efforts over the next campaign.

<Highlight 2>: The annual agricultural fair

In June, Dahari organized an agricultural fair at Mutsamudu. The objective was to permit at the farmers supported by Dahari to sold during one day their productions and promote the sustainable agriculture. The fair was a success with more than 800 visitors to bought the products of 81 farmers from 10 villages. The main products sold have been:

Banana: 150 bunches

Manioc: 109 bags (25 kg each)Dasheen: 36 bags (25kg each)

Sweet potatoes: 63 bags (25kg each)
