Within the conservation of the biodiversity, the staff of Dahari responsible of the natural resources management realized the 9 of November, a field visit on the roost site of the fruit bat Livingstone's in Kangani (Nyumakele area). The staff met the landholder of the site, Mr Ahamadi Abdallah Djoumoi to discuss the process to put in place the futur agreement between him and Dahari, to protect the roost site.
