< Highlight 1>: Consultation meetings with communities for small grant provision for piloting alternative livelihood along Hponganrazi Wildlife Sanctuary

To reduce stress on fish and wildlife biodiversity and find out regular income for the local communities, project team organized village consultation meetings in the villages along Hponganrazi Wildlife Sanctuary. Local communities were willing to start new livelihood opportunities such as poultry rearing, perennial crop plantation, home gardening and fencing for home gardens.

< Highlight 2>: Field trip along the Mali Hka River for fly fishing tourism

According to important of alternative livelihood for local communities, fly fishing is one of the potential livelihoods for the region based on the local fish species, snow trout, masher and tor. Therefore, project team organized field trip along the Mali Hka River together with international fly fishing consultant to find out potential locations and conducted meetings with local communities and explained about fly fishing tourism.

<Highlight 3>: Workshop on the Establishment of Locally Managed Freshwater Areas for the Development of Alternative Livelihood Opportunity

According to important of fly fishing tourism for the development of the region, project organized workshop in collaboration with the Union level Department of Fisheries, local authorities and local communities in Putao. Director General of the Department of Fisheries and District Director of the General Administrative Department delivered opening speech. International and local fly fishing consultants presented potential opportunity of fly fishing tourism and FFI presented FFI survey results and important fish species found in the region.

<Highlight 4>: Veterinary Training to the local communities from the Hponganrazi Wildlife Sanctuary
According to necessity of the knowledge on poultry raising, project organized 5 days training in collaboration with the District Livestock Department to the local communities in Putao.
