Each family was given a report on the socio-economic situation of their farm.</p>	
<p><Highlight 5>: Consolidation of a touristic project in La Germania continues. During November and October, four meetings with the community of La Germania (San Vicente de Chucurí) were carried out to continue advancing in the creation of a tourism project. The name of the project and a first draft of the statutes were agreed.</p>	
<p><Highlight 6>: Visit of the coordinator of the Satoyama project for the realization of a programmatic and financial site visit. At the end of December, Devon Dublin visited the project site. A tour of Las Cruces micro-basin was organized and the community presented the results of different ongoing activities, including the eco-agrotourism project, the use of the agricultural calendar and the magnolia recovery actions. During the visit the presentation of the tourism initiative</p>	

and the knowledge exchange estates by the participants took place. Furthermore, the research team presented advances and forward looking actions of the project.
